

# Culminating Service Project Display Guidelines

Take Pictures While Doing Your Project!

**Electronic Draft Due: *No later than October 5, 2011***

***Your powerpoint/film must:***

- Be 3-5 minutes long;
- Include:
  - The title of your project
  - Your name(s)
  - The timeframe when you did your project (e.g., "Summer, 2011")
  - Photographs. *(If the organization does not allow you to photograph people involved in the project, talk with your supervisor about photographs which are permissible – for example, the back sides of people, the building, and even photos available through the organization web-site.)*

***Your powerpoint/film will cover three topics – in any creative way:***

**I Social Issue Information:** Offer your background research that helps you understand the population/issue and do your service. Using graphs, statistics and charts, answer such questions as:

- Who is this population/what is this issue?
- What are the needs/challenges for this population/issue?
- How available are services to this population?
- How do they relate to the program/project you worked on?

**II Project Explanation:** Provide an overview of your service. This section should include answers to such questions as:

- Whom did you serve?
- At what organization?
- What did you do (beginning, middle, end)?
- How did you culminate your project?
- During what time period?

**III Effect of Experience:** Offer your reflections on the overall experience, including comments on:

- how you personally changed and grew;
- the impact your service had upon the community;
- values you learned in doing your service.
